Representative image MUMBAI: Weighed down by higher expenses due to the devastating impact of the Coronavirus pandemic on the economy, the government on Friday said it will borrow about Rs 12 lakh crore from the market in fiscal year 2020-21, a massive increase of Rs 4.2 lakh crore, or 54% jump over the Budget estimate of Rs 7.8 lakh crore.

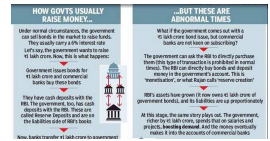

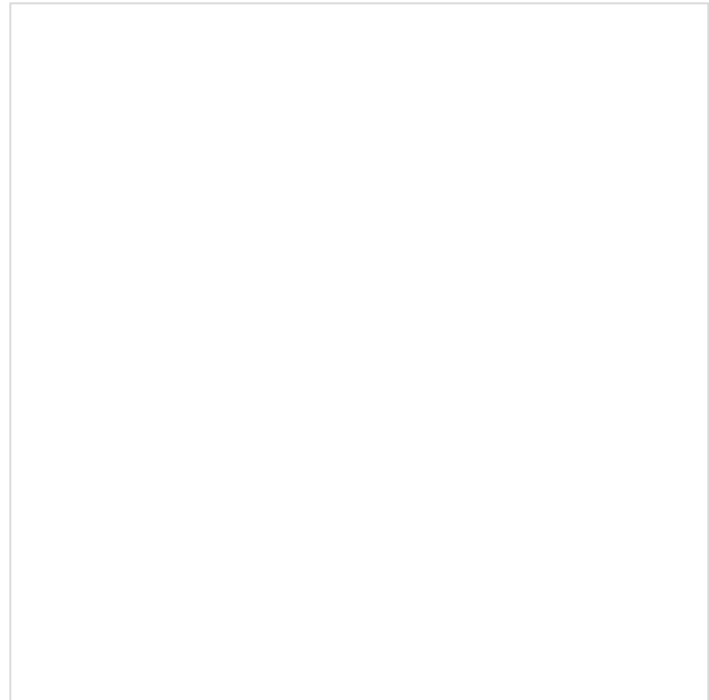
